Dear Friends,

Thank you so much for the gestures of appreciation and heartfelt recognition of my 15th ordination anniversary. The surprise fellowship, cake, and cards (not to mention mimosas) were perfect. I thank God for you.

The day I was called to serve Saint John is one of the happiest and proudest moments of my life. I rejoiced not because I finally had a job after years of school and internships and loans, but because I was called to YOU. Through college I dreamed of one day pastoring a congregation LIKE Saint John. I consider it a great honor and a holy thing to be the pastor OF Saint John.

First calls are supposed to be 3-4 years and then you move on. The average pastorate for Lutherans is 8 ¼ years and then you get a new one. Yet here we are. 15 years and going strong. You took a chance on me all those years ago. I was fresh out of seminary with very little experience in the real world. You gave me a shot. For that I will never cease giving thanks. I will serve tirelessly to ensure you weren't wrong. I know that I've made mistakes along the way. I am sorry for any disappointment, discouragement, or disagreement I created here. It was never intended. I only hope that in the end you will find my love, service, care, and friendship as more than enough to cover those errors.

In marriage we ask partners: can you share and receive grace? Will you forgive as you've been forgiven? To me, that's not just a question for married people but one for the church. For 15 years we've answered yes. We are here together not because I'm so good or the church is so good, but because we're so good together. That goodness is built on grace. It's built on love. It's built on commitment. Many years ago, I shared an opinion at a council meeting that wasn't quite unanimously shared by the room. In that moment I said: I reserve the right to be wrong. We all laughed. In the end, I was wrong, but it all worked out because at this congregation we share and receive grace.


We will be stuffing the stockings with donated age-appropriate items.
