# COUNCIL UPDATE

The January council meeting was held on the 18th at 7:00PM via Zoom. The meeting began with prayer and a welcome to the new council members (Shirleen Besch and Brian Hirschey). Pastor presided over the meeting as officers for the new council were elected. The following people were elected to executive positions...

After the election, President Cote presided over the meeting.

Pastor provided a report that included ongoing ministry and two baptisms. A discussion was held regarding the profane and vulgar disruption of our worship on January 9th. Safeguards are now in place to ensure that will never happen again. Security training for the congregation will be explored in the coming months. Pastor noted that the Outdoor Ministry Center design plans are nearly finalized.

The committees offered the following reports...

**Fellowship** – January events, including a soup luncheon and trip to a performance at Shea's 710 Theatre were postponed due to COVID. We expect life to pick up again in February.

Worship and Music – Services will resume in-person on February 6. Remote, virtual worship will continue to be provided.

Christian Education – Sunday School will resume in the coming weeks. Teachers will be needed when that time comes.

**Youth** – Youth events, including confirmation and Youth Group, will resume in-person in February. Youth Group is set for February 8th. Confirmation is scheduled for February 13th.

**Personnel** – Our administrative assistant Sara is going back to school. In-person office hours are now Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday from 9 AM-2 PM.

Building and Grounds – A preventative maintenance plan is being explored to care for our heating system.

**Stewardship** – The act of "pledging" is encouraged by the committee. Our congregation gave \$2,761 to World Hunger in 2021 in response to emergencies.

Finance – We finished 2021 with a surplus of roughly \$25,000. We enter 2022 in a relatively strong financial position.

In the business portion of the meeting various drawings of the proposed Outdoor Ministry Center were considered. A rendering of the altar was shared for the first time and the council affirmed the plans and approved moving forward with this exciting project. Fundraising will start in March of 2022.

The meeting adjourned with the Lord's Prayer.




